



Reopening of offline classes for Diploma, UG, and PG Students

Given the recent notification from the office of the Chief Secretary, Government of Meghalaya (see link below), it is anticipated that offline classes on campus will be reopened. The following is the schedule for reopening:

UG 1st, 3rd and 5th Semester and Diploma 3rd semester: September 20, 2021

PG 3rd Semester and Diploma 1st Semester: September 27, 2021

PG 1st Semester: October 4, 2021

As all faculty and staff are vaccinated or RTPCR negative, it is expected that students will be likewise protected. All students must have taken the first dose of vaccination or show a negative RTPCR report (every 10 days) to be eligible to enter the campus. All vaccinated students will be required to submit a copy of their vaccination certificate and expected date of second dose if not already taken. On campus all applicable Covid protocols will be strictly followed.

Please note the following:

1. The Head of Department/mentors/coordinators will contact students with additional information as needed.
2. All students should periodically visit the MLCU website for updated information, including registration procedures when students return to campus.

ORDER

In continuation to Order No. POL.75/2020/PLI/111 dated 20-08-2021, the following additional activities are permitted in the State with effect from 1st September, 2021:

1. Re-opening of Educational Institutions subject to compliance with SoP being issued by the Education Department.
2. Central Government offices and State Government offices may function at 100% strength and shall close at 5:00 PM daily.
3. Banks and Post Offices may function at 100% strength and shall close at 5:00 PM daily.
4. Inter-District movement is permitted. However, movement of commercial vehicles into East Khasi Hills District shall be regulated by the Deputy Commissioner, East Khasi Hills district.
5. Re-opening of tourism for local, domestic and international tourists subject to compliance with the SoP being issued by the Tourism Department.
6. Reopening of restaurants and bars at maximum 50% strength subject to compliance with the SoP to be issued by the respective Deputy Commissioners.

All permissions are subject to strict observance of the COVID-related protocols. All concerned are advised to refer to the relevant SoPs for further details and necessary compliance.
