3. Convocation:

- a) Convocation Date: September 23, 2025, 10:00 a.m
- b) Registration on the Convocation day for in Person is 8:00 a.m to 9:30 a.m
- c) **Venue**: Lariti International Centre for Performing Arts and Culture (LICPAC)
- d) Last date for students applying in person: September 18, 2025
- e) Students attending the convocation in person are to collect the traditional robe from the Main Campus, 2nd Floor Room 305 from August 25th, 2025 to September 18th, 2025 from 2:00p.m. to 5:00p.m.
- f) All students attending the convocation in person are to come for rehearsal on the **22**nd **September 2025** at the venue. Rehearsal timing is at **1 p.m. SHARP**. The allotment of seat numbers will be done on the rehearsal day.

- g) All students will receive their **Original Graduation Certificate** upon returning their robes immediately after the convocation at the designated tables in the venue. A fine of Rs 4500 only will be charged for lost or damaged of robes.
- h) All participating students must wear the robe prescribed by the University.
- i) Participants must arrive at the designated venue for registration at the time specified before the commencement of the ceremony.
- j) Participants must conduct themselves with dignity and respect throughout the ceremony.
- k) Graduating students will be allowed to enter the convocation hall only at the proper time interval.
- 1) All late comers including graduates, faculty and guests will enter the convocation hall and be seated only at three specific points: after the national anthem, after reading the holy books and after presenting the report of the university.
- m) Students applying in absentia can collect their certificates from the Evaluation and Examinations Department at Nongrah, Shillong one week after the Convocation Day. Students who are unable to collect their own original documents are required to issue an authorization letter or send an authorized email attaching a copy of their student's ID after the Convocation day.
- n) Students who wished their certificates to be sent to their home address, are required to send an email requesting for the same and a postal fee of Rs. 150/- (within India) will be applicable. However, for students outside India, postal fee will be as per the applicable fees.
- o) **NOTE**: On the day of convocation, parents/guardians who come along with the student will have to bring their invitation card given by Martin Luther Christian University.
